Dear Brothers and Sisters!

I cordially greet all of you as you have gathered together for the 5<sup>th</sup> International Charity Festival of Christian Culture 'Russia-Greece. Together through the Centuries'.

This meeting held at the walls of the magnificent Cathedral of the Resurrection, the main church of the Russian Federation Armed Forces at the Patriot Park near Moscow, has been timed for the 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the beginning of the national liberation struggle of the Greek people and for the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the glorification of Admiral Fyodor Ushakov as a saint.
