Patriarchal Exarch for South-East Asia meets with Indonesia's minister of religious affairs



On 11 March 2020, Metropolitan Sergiy of Singapore and South-East Asia, Patriarchal Exarch for South-East Asia, met with the Indonesian Minister of Religious Affairs, Mr. Fahrul Razi.

Metropolitan Sergiy extended congratulation to Mr. Razi on this appointment in October 2019 as minister of religious affairs in the largest Muslim country in the world.
