



DECR representative takes part in Religions for Peace meeting in New York

On 11th – 13th December 2019, the *Religions for Peace* International organized a meeting in New York, bringing together over 200 representatives of religious traditions from various countries.

The participants in the meeting discussed a strategic plan for the 2020-2025 term and summarized the results of the organization's activities over the period which has passed since the *Religions for Peace* 10th World Assembly held in the city of Lindau, Germany, in August 2019.
