



Annual session of the 'Dialogue of Civilizations' Rhodes Forum takes place in Greece



The 17th session of the World Public Forum – Dialogue of Civilizations was held on the island of Rhodes on October 11-12, 2019. Taking part in the session were prominent representatives of different states, politicians, scientists, businessmen and journalists who discussed various forms of dialogue among nations and cultures with the purpose of facilitating peaceful development, prosperity and stability.

Attending the forum with the blessing of Metropolitan Hilarion, chairman of the Moscow Patriarchate's Department for External Church Relations (DECR) was Archpriest Sergy Zvonarev, DECR secretary for far abroad countries.
