



A hierarchy of Serbian Orthodox Church visits Department for External Church Relations



On June 10, 2019, Bishop Arsenije of Nis, Serbian Orthodox Church, who is on a pilgrim trip to holy places of the Russian Orthodox Church, visited the St. Daniel Patriarchal Monastery and the Department for External Church Relations of the Moscow Patriarchate, in which he was received by Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk.

Present at the meeting were also A. Khoshev, a student of the Sts Cyril and Methodius Institute of Post-Graduate Studies (CMI), and the clergy and sub-deacons of the diocese of Nis, who accompanied their archpastor on his pilgrimage.
