International Conference 'The Holy Scriptures in the Changing World' takes place in Etchmiadzin

On September 28-October 2, 2018, the International Conference 'The Holy Scriptures in the Changing World' was held in Etchmiadzin, Armenia, sponsored by the United Bible Societies (UBS) with the participation of the Local Orthodox Churches and the Ancient Oriental Churches.
