



## His Holiness Patriarch Kirill chairs regular session of Supreme Church Council



On 7 September 2018, at the Cathedral of Christ the Saviour in Moscow, the Supreme Church Council held its regular session under the chairmanship of His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia.

His Holiness Patriarch Kirill delivered an opening address.

Discussed at the meeting were various issues pertaining to the theological education. Archpriest Maxim Kozlov, chairman of the Education Committee of the Russian Orthodox Church, presented a report on master's degree programmes and on the evaluation of graduation theses at the theological educational institutions. The participants in the meeting also heard reports on parish youth work.
