

Patronal feast celebrated at the Russian Orthodox Church's Representation in Damascus



On 11 February 2018, Sunday of the Last Judgment and commemoration day of the translation of the relics of the Holy Hieromartyr Ignatius the God-Bearer, the Divine Liturgy was celebrated at the church of the Russian Orthodox Church's Representation in Damascus, consecrated in honour of this saint, first bishop of Antioch.
