



On June 16, Archbishop Sergy celebrated the requiem litiya at the monument to the fallen sailors of the Russian cruiser Varyag in the city of Incheon and laid flowers.

That same day he visited St. Nicholas Cathedral in Seoul and met with Metropolitan Ambrose of Seoul (Ecumenical Patriarchate). Hierarchs of the fraternal Local Orthodox Churches offered up prayers and venerated the shrines in the cathedral and in the church of St. Maximus the Greek. They discussed issues pertaining to the history of the Orthodox mission in Korea and situation at present, as well as common witness about the truths of Orthodoxy before the rapidly secularizing modern world.

Later in the day Archbishop Sergy met with the president of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of Korea and with the head of the Anglican Church of Korea, and with the Mayor of Seoul.
