## Patriarch Kirill chairs a session of the Holy Synod

Asia; Metropolitan Varsonofy of St. Petersburg and Ladoga, chancellor of the Moscow Patriarchate; Metropolitan Pavel of Minsk and Zaslavsk, Patriarchal Exarch for All Belarus; Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk, head of the Department for External Church Relations.

The following bishops were summoned for the winter session: Metropolitan Melety of Chernovtsy and Bukovina; Metropolitan Seraphim of Penza and Nizhny Lomov; Archbishop Yelisey of Sourozh; Archbishop Nikolay of Salekhard and Novo-Urengoy; Bishop Pitirim of Dushanbe and Tajikistan.
