## Primate of the Russian Orthodox Church celebrates at the Church of the Resurrection in Zurich

On 7 December 2016, His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia celebrated the Divine liturgy at the Church of the Resurrection in Zurich.

We thank You for the great joy which You are giving us, your children.'

Archpriest Mikhail presented His Holiness with an icon of the holy martyrs Felix, Regula and Exuperancia, patron saints of Zurich.

The Primate of the Russian Orthodox Church delivered a homily, congratulated the community on the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary, thanked all people working here, especially wardens, decorators and builders, donated an icon of the Saviour to the church,

and presented awards of the Russian Orthodox Church to several people in consideration of help they rendered to the Church of the Resurrection in Zurich.
