



His Beatitude Metropolitan Rastislav celebrates All-Night Vigil at Representation of the Orthodox Church of Czech Lands and Slovakia in Moscow

After the service, Archimandrite Seraphim (Shemyatovsky) greeted His Beatitude Metropolitan Rastislav and wished him longevity and God's help in his Primatial ministry.

The Primate of the Orthodox Church of the Czech Lands and Slovakia expressed his gratitude to His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia for the opportunity to visit the Russian Orthodox Church.
