



Administrator of Patriarchal parishes in the USA and head of the Moscow Patriarchate's Administration for Institutions Abroad celebrate Liturgy at the Patriarchal cathedral in New York



On 7 August 2016, the 7th Sunday after Pentecost, Bishop John of Naro-Fominsk, administrator of the Patriarchal parishes in the USA, and Bishop Antony of Bogorodsk, head of the Moscow Patriarchate's Administration for Institutions Abroad, who is on a working visit in the USA upon the blessing of His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia, celebrated the Divine Liturgy at St Nicholas Cathedral in New York City in concelebration with the clergy of the church.
