I would like to express my sincere condolences to you, the clergy and faithful of the Roman Catholic Church in France, as well as to the relatives, friends and spiritual children of the slain pastor.

May God, Who 'so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life' (Jn. 3:16), repose the soul of His servant in the heavenly mansions and give consolation and support to all the victims and send peace and blessing to the French people.
