



Commemoration Day of St Nicholas the Wonderworker celebrated in Bari

On 22 May 2016, the feast of translation of the relics of St Nicholas the Wonderworker from Myra in Lycia to Bari, Bishop Antony of Bogorodsk, administrator of the Moscow Patriarchate's parishes in Italy, participated in the divine service at the Basilica of St Nicholas in Bari.

Officiating at the Liturgy was Metropolitan Juvenaly of Krutitsy and Kolomna.
