

DECR chairman sends greetings to Metropolitan Amfilohije of Montenegro and Primorje on the occasion of the 30th anniversary of his episcopal consecration and the 25th anniversary of his election to the See of Cetinje

Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk, chairman of the Moscow Patriarchate's Department for External Church Relations, sent a message of greetings to Metropolitan Amfilohije of Montenegro and Primorje. The text of the message is given below.
