



Metropolitan Hilarion meets with His Beatitude Archbishop Hieronymos of Athens



On 17 December 2015, Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk, chairman of the Moscow Patriarchate's Department for External Church Relations, who had arrived in Athens with the blessing of His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia to take part in a session of the Special Inter-Orthodox Committee for the Preparation of the Pan-Orthodox Council, met with His Beatitude Archbishop Hieronymos of Athens and All Greece.
