

## Closing ceremony of the 6th "Golden Knight" Slavic Arts Forum takes place in Moscow

On 6 December 2015, the closing ceremony of the 6<sup>th</sup> "Golden Knight" Slavic Arts Forum took place at the Hall of Church Councils of the Cathedral of Christ the Saviour in Moscow.

This year marks the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary both of the forum and the Ministry of the Russian Federation for Civil Defence, Emergencies and Elimination of Consequences of Natural Disasters (EMERCOM). Among those who attended the ceremony were Mr. Vladimir Puchkov, EMERCOM Minister; H.E. Slavenko Terzich, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Serbia to the Russian Federation; H.E. Boiko Kocev, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Bulgaria to the Russian Federation; and the EMERCOM staff members.
