Metropolitan Hilarion meets with a group of pilgrims from Colombia



On August 1, 2014, Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk, head of the Moscow Patriarchate's department for external church relations, received a group of pilgrims from the Archdiocese of Manizales, Colombia, led by Archbishop Gonzalo Restrepo Restrepo. for the warm welcome and invited him to visit the Archdiocese of Manizales.
