



Metropolitan Hilarion speaks at Ss Cyril and Methodius Jubilee Readings



On 25 June 2013, the Ss Cyril and Methodius Jubilee Readings opened at the All-Russia State Library for Foreign Literature. The Readings are sponsored by the Ss Cyril and Methodius Theological Institute of Post-Graduate and Doctoral Studies and the All-Russia State Library for Foreign Literature with support of 'Meta' Education Centre. Among those taking part in the meeting were archimandrite Teoctist (Dimitrov), representative of the Patriarch of Bulgaria to the Patriarch of Moscow and All Russia and rector of the Bulgarian metochion in Moscow; faculty and student of the Ss Cyril and Methodius Theological Institute; Slavonic scholars from Russia and from abroad.
