



## Reception in honour of Patriarch Theophilos of Jerusalem in St. Petersburg

On May 30, 2013, a dinner was given by the St. Petersburg Metropolia in honour of His Beatitude Patriarch Theophilos III of Jerusalem, who is on an official visit to the Russian Orthodox Church.
