



His Holiness Patriarch Kirill discusses preparations for the celebration of 1025th anniversary of the Baptism of Rus' with Chancellor of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church and head of Ukrainian President's Administration

On 4 March 2013, His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia received Metropolitan Antony of Borispol, chancellor of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church, and Mr. Serhiy Lyovochkin, head of the Presidential Administration of Ukraine.

Among the issues discussed at the meeting was the preparation for the joint celebration of the 1025th anniversary of the Baptism of Rus'.
