



Supreme Church Council of Russian Orthodox Church meets for regular session at Church of Christ the Saviour under chairmanship of Patriarch Kirill

On April 3, 2012, the Russian Orthodox Church's Supreme Church Council met for a regular session at the Church of Christ the Saviour. It is chaired by His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia.

In his introductory remarks, His Holiness presented the agenda and shared his thoughts about the strategy of the Russian Orthodox Church's cooperation with the mass media, the Patriarchal Press Services has reported.

Patriarch Kirill said in particular, 'The most important thing that the Church should convey to people is the good news of salvation. The word of the Church, even in a situation of conflict, should bear reconciling power. In no way, should it be associated in people's consciousness with aggressiveness or cruelty, or break away from the primary mission of the Church, which is to bear witness to the peace of Christ'.

The Council will consider the progress made in implementation of its decisions and reports about the work carried out by Synodal institutions in 2011. The Council's members will also consider topical problems of the Church's presence in the informational space and adopt the theme of the 21st International Christmas Readings in 2013.
