A letter has come to His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia from His Beatitude Patriarch Daniel of Romania expressing condolences over the tragedy that took place on March 29 in the Moscow underground.

'We convey condolences to the mourning families and to those grieved because of these irresponsible deeds, on behalf of the hierarchs, priests and faithful of the Romanian Orthodox Church. We pray Merciful God to rest in peace the souls of those tragically deceased and to bring comfort to their families', the Patriarch says in his letter.

'We express our hope that such inhuman deeds will never occur again, and the spirit of love and good understanding among people will prevail over any violent manifestation against innocent people', His Beatitude writes.
