On February 25, the feast day of the Iberian Icon of the Mother of God and the commemoration day of St. Alexis Metropolitan of Moscow, His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia and His Beatitude Metropolitan Vladimir of Kiev and All Ukraine celebrated the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gift at the refectory church of the Live Laura of the Caves.
