



Archbishop Hilarion meets with Ambassador of the Lithuanian Republic to the Russian Federation

On 20 January 2010, Ambassador Antanas Vinkus of the Lithuanian Republic to the Russian Federation gave a dinner in honour of Archbishop Hilarion of Volokolamsk, chairman of the Moscow Patriarchate Department for external church relations.

Present were Andrius Tuckus, counselor of a European Parliament deputy, and Juosas Budraitis, cultural attaché of the Embassy of the Lithuanian Republic and national artist of Lithuania.

A wide range of topics was discussed, including the upcoming celebration of the 20th anniversary of independence of the Lithuanian Republic and prospects of His Holiness Patriarch Kirill's visit to Lithuania. An important topic of the discussion was a closer cultural cooperation between the Lithuanian Republic and the Russian Orthodox Church.
