

Bishop Matthew of Sourozh meets with Russian children under treatment in London



On March 9, 2021, after the Divine Liturgy, the temporary administrator of the Patriarchal Parishes in the USA and Canada, Bishop Matthew of Sourozh, met with parents and children from Russia undergoing in the capital city of the Great Britain a medical treatment supported by humanitarian foundations and organizations and patronized by the Pomoshch [Help] group from Cathedral of the Dormition in London.

In the Diocese of Sourozh this work is carried out by the voluntary service of the Department for Church Charity and Social Service. The Pomoshch group consisting of volunteer parishioners of the Cathedral of the Dormition has been successfully working under the department for several years now.
