On April 13, in the Throne Hall of the Patriarchal and Synodal Residence at St. Daniel's Monastery in Moscow, the Holy Synod of the Russian Orthodox Church held its first session in 2021 under the chairmanship of His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia.

His Holiness addressed the Holy Synod members with an opening speech.
