The Decree states, 'For his considerable contribution to the development of international and inter-confessional relations, longstanding conscientious work, Grigory Valerievich Alfeyev (Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk), head of the Department for External Church Relations of the Moscow Patriarchate, be awarded the Order of St. Alexander Nevsky.'
