On 17th June 2021, in the Throne Hall of the Patriarchal and Synodal residence at St. Daniel's Monastery in Moscow, the Holy Synod of the Russian Orthodox Church began its regular session under the chairmanship of His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Russia.

Prior to the meeting, His Holiness Patriarch Kirill presented its agenda.
