



DECR deputy chairman attends opening ceremony of I.A.O. 28th General Assembly



The 28th General Assembly of the Interparliamentary Assembly on Orthodoxy (I.A.O.) opened on Crete, Greece, on July 22, 2021. The topic of the meeting is “The World’s Future, the Future of Europe after Pandemic.”

Today, the I.A.O. unites over twenty states. Russia joined the organization in 1994. The delegation of the RF Federal Assembly to the 28th I.A.O. Assembly is led by Mr. Sergei A. Gavrillov, President of the I.A.O. and chairman of the State Duma Committee for development of civil society and affairs of public and religious organizations.
