I congratulate all of you on the great feast - the Day of the Baptism of Rus' and the commemoration day of your Baptizer - Holy and Most Orthodox Prince Vladimir Equal-to-the-Apostles.

Your personality and firmly steering the boat of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church in this very hard time, our dear Brother in Christ, have become a symbol of faithfulness to the unity of the Orthodox Church and a brave opposition to temptations. There, together with the late Metropolitan Amfilohije, you prayed for the unity of the Church and led a procession with the cross, which showed that we, Orthodox Serbs, just as the Ukrainian people, will be known to the world because of our faithfulness to Christ and opposition to temptations, which the prince of this world sets before us.

On the day of this great feast, I would like to express to you my great gratitude for the help and love. Thanks to them and to the intercession of Holy Prince Vladimir and St. Sava of Serbia, the Holy Orthodox Church in Serbia, in Ukraine and everywhere, where the faithfulness to Holy Scriptures and canonical order is preserved, will be a glorious victor over the powers of this world.

Your Beatitude, once again, I cordially greet you on the feast, lifting up prayers to the Lord that He may send you strength for further service of your Church and your faithful people.
