

Archbishop Nestor of Madrid and Lisbon blesses chapel in the south of Portugal



On 28 August 2021, the feast day of the Dormition of the Most Holy Mother of God, Archbishop Nestor of Madrid and Lisbon celebrated the Divine Liturgy in Quarteira, Portugal.
