



Metropolitan Hilarion expressed condolences upon the death of composer Mikis Theodorakis



Renowned Greek composer Mikis Theodorakis died in the 97th year of his life on September 2, 2021. A message of condolence to his family and friends was sent by the Chairman of the Department for External Church Relations of the Moscow Patriarchate, Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk.
