Bishop-elect of Kafa hegumen Peter elevated to the rank of archimandrite.

On 16th October 2022, on the 16th Sunday after Pentecost, the chairman of the Department of External Church Relations of the Moscow Patriarchate the metropolitan of Volokolamsk Anthony celebrated the Divine Liturgy in the Church of Saint John the Baptist 'na Presne' in Moscow.

Concelebrating with the metropolitan were the cleric of the diocese of Madrid and Lisbon hegumen Peter (Pruteanu), the deputy chairman of the DECR archpriest Nikolai Lischenyuk, archpriest Dionysy Lobov, and deacons Yevgeny Kuznetsov and Nikolai Vasin, as reported by the parish website. The liturgical hymns were performed by the festive choir of the church under the direction of choir mistress Tatiana Vorontsova.
