On 30th November the chairman of the Department for External Church Relations of the Moscow Patriarchate the metropolitan of Volokolamsk Anthony took part in a session of the board of directors of the Foundation for the Support and Protection of the Rights of Compatriots Living Abroad, which was presided over by the Russian foreign minister Sergei Lavrov.

The session was also attended by the Russian justice minister K. A.
