Patriarch of Antioch grieves over persecutions against Ukrainian Orthodox Church

"In these days of the Great Lent on the eve of the commemoration of the Holy Salvific Passions of Christ, we have taken with great sorrow the truly painful news about the situation of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church", stressed His Beatitude John X, Patriarch of Great Antioch and All the East, in his letter to His Holiness Patriarch Krill of Moscow and All Russia. "Today, together with you we are enduring the gravest moments in our and your history", Patriarch John writes mentioning in particular the ongoing war conflict.
