On March 30, the official page of the Michalovce and Kosice diocese of the Orthodox Church of the Czech lands and Slovakia posted a commentary on the social networking site of the diocesan administrator, Archbishop George, regarding the situation around the Kiev Pechersk Lavra. The hierarch concluded his comment with an appeal: "Please come to your senses before it is too late, let the monks live and pray in their Lavra! After all, they are people, not things to be moved; they are citizens of Ukraine, not enemies; their lives are not your property!"
