On May 28, 2023, on the Sunday of the Holy Fathers of the First Ecumenical Council, His Grace Bishop Matthew of Sourozh, temporarily Administrator of the Patriarchal Parishes in the United States and Canada, concelebrated with Archbishop Irénée (Rochon) of Ottawa and Canada, Orthodox Church in America, in the church of St. Gregory of Nyssa in Kingston, in the southern Canadian province of Ontario.

At the Divine Liturgy, Archpastors were assisted by Archpriest Andrew Anderson, Archpriest Stelian Liabotis, and Deacon Denis Letunovsky.
