On December 10, the 27th Sunday after Pentecost and feast day of the “Sign” icon of the Most Holy Theotokos, Metropolitan Anthony of Volokolamsk, chairman of the Moscow Patriarchate’s Department for External Church Relations, currently on a working visit to France with the blessing of His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Rus’, and Metropolitan Nestor of Chersonesus and Western Europe, Patriarchal Exarch of Western Europe, celebrated Divine Liturgy at the Cathedral Church of the Holy Trinity in Paris.
