



Acting Patriarchal Exarch of Africa visits South African Republic

On January 11, Bishop Konstantin of Zarskoye, Acting Patriarchal Exarch of Africa began his visit to the South African Republic. Accompanying him with the blessing of Metropolitan Anthony of Volokolamsk, chairman of the Moscow Patriarchate's Department for External Church Relations (DECR), is hieromonk Stefan (Igumnov), DECR secretary for inter-Christian Relations.

Meeting them at Johannesburg airport was archpriest Daniil Lugovoy, rector of the local church of St. Sergius of Radonezh.
