



Russian Church representative takes part in celebrations marking 30th anniversary of the Department of Ecumenical Relations and Development of the Patriarchate of Antioch

On November 8th, at the invitation of Patriarch John X of Antioch and All the East, Archimandrite Philip (Vasiltsev), representative of the Patriarch of Moscow and All Rus' to the Patriarchal Throne of Antioch, took part in the celebrations marking the 30th anniversary of the foundation of the Department of Ecumenical Relations and Development of the Patriarchate of Antioch. The event took place in the Damascus Opera House.
