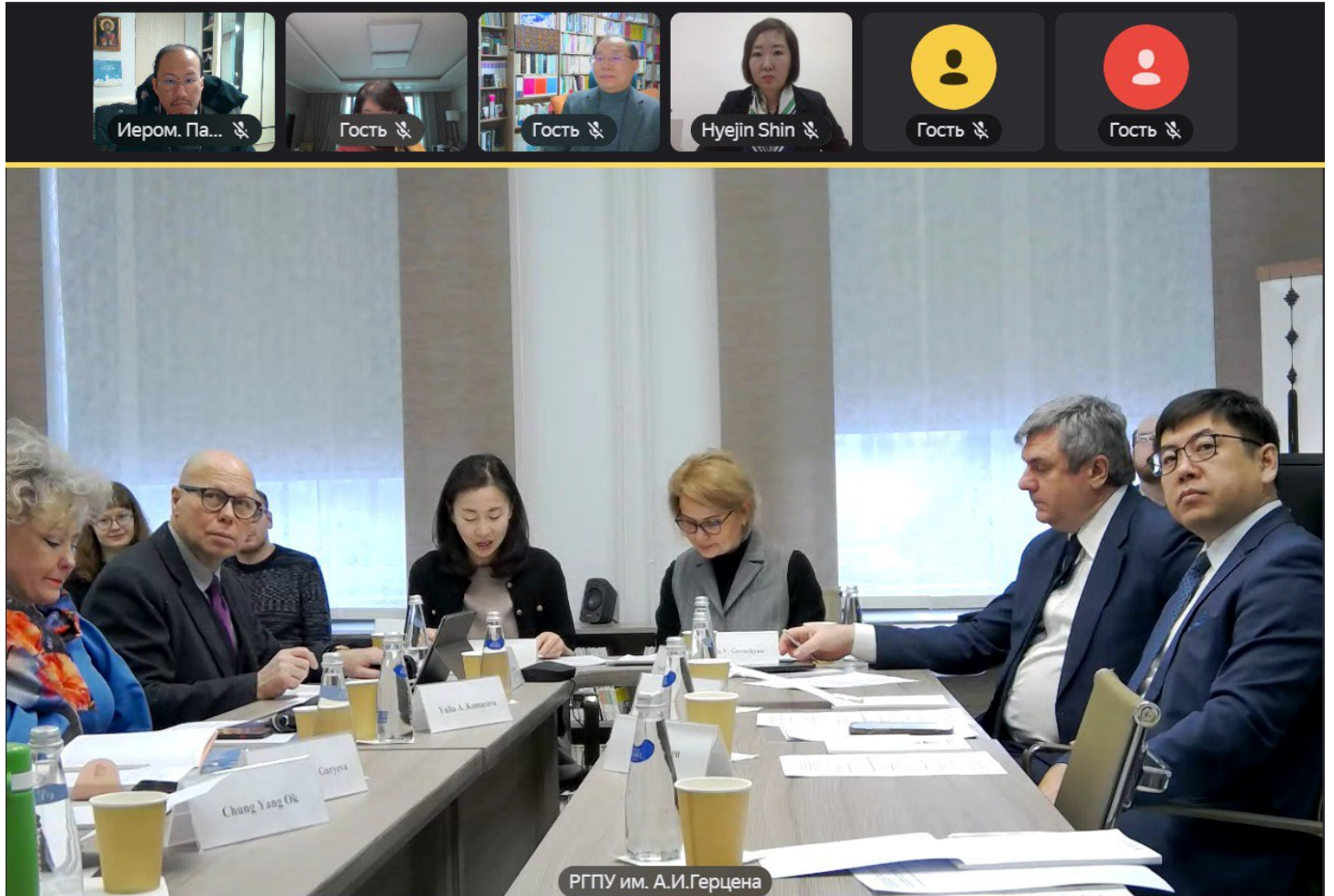




Cleric of the Diocese of Korea speaks at the readings “Relations between Russia and Korea: 120 years ago and now”
