



## DECR representative takes part in interfaith forum in Moscow

On February 12<sup>th</sup>, an International Academic and Research Conference on Intercultural Cooperation as a Factor in Preserving Traditional Spiritual and Moral Values took place in Moscow. It was organised by the Centralised Religious Organisation “International Islamic Mission” in collaboration with the Foundation for Support of Islamic Culture, Science and Education and the Moscow State Linguistic University.
