



Representative of the DECR participates in Interreligious Roundtable

On February 25, a roundtable discussion on the topic "The Experience of Religious Organizations in Working with Military Personnel and Veterans of the Special Military Operation (SMO)" was held in Kazan in a hybrid format. The event was organized by the Bulgarian Islamic Academy (BIA).

The main goal of the roundtable was to exchange experiences among representatives of religious organizations on strengthening the spiritual and moral foundations of military service, fostering a healthy climate within military units, and supporting the families of military personnel.

Bibarsov; and others, including representatives of state authorities, public organizations, religious figures, as well as master's and doctoral students of the BIA.
