His Holiness Patriarch Kirill sends condolences over devastating earthquake in Myanmar and Thailand

On 28th March 2025, the 7.7-magnitude earthquake hit Myanmar, with strong tremors felt in five neighbouring countries, including Thailand. In Myanmar, over 140 people died, over 700 were injured.
