



His Holiness Patriarch Kirill presides over final 2025 session of the Holy Synod of the Russian Orthodox Church

On December 26, His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Rus' presided over the final session of the Holy Synod of the Russian Orthodox Church in the outgoing year 2025.

Opening the session, which took place at the Patriarchal and Synodal Residence in the Danilov Monastery in Moscow, the Primate of the Russian Orthodox Church addressed the participants with a brief greeting. After that, the Holy Synod began its work according to the agenda, the Patriarchal Press Service reports.
