



## “Children Paint in Church” educational event takes place in Holy Trinity Cathedral in Paris

On 18<sup>th</sup> March 2026, a cultural and educational event entitled “Children Paint in Church” took place at the Holy Trinity Cathedral in Paris, bringing together local Russian-speaking children, including pupils of Sunday schools and other educational institutions.
