On 13th May 2026, an Applied Research Conference on Sport, Education and Spirituality: Integrating Physical and Spiritual Development took place at the Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation.

Acting as moderators were Vladimir Zorin, Chairman of the Civic Chamber Commission on Interethnic and Interreligious Relations and Migration, and Sergey Ryakhovsky, Presiding Bishop of the Russian United Union of Christians of Evangelical Faith (Pentecostals).
