Greeting the high guest, Metropolitan Hilarion noted that the Moscow Patriarchate devotes close and respectful attention to the activities of the United Nations.

The archpastor told Ms. Espinosa Garcés about the present-day structure of the Russian Orthodox Church, as well as about the activities of the Department for External Church Relations and Church's interaction with the external world.

The participants in the meeting discussed a number of topical issues facing the world today, such as the persecutions of Christians in the Middle East. Metropolitan Hilarion also mentioned the ecclesiastical situation in Ukraine, presenting to the high-ranking international official facts of pressure and oppression that the faithful of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church are suffering.

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
